STATEMENT OF NEUTRALITY (READ FIRST)

This NTI is a neutral, evidence-gathering request. It is not a complaint, allegation, or legal claim. It seeks documentary proof of safeguards against anti-Black racism in decisions affecting IC3 Black and IC6 Mixed-Black people and requests records needed to test whether decisions were free from racial bias. Recipients must not mischaracterise this NTI as an accusation.

ENTITY PROFILE (CONTEXT FOR THIS NTI)

- Entity: All-Party Parliamentary Group for Afrikan Reparations (APPG-AR).
- Status: APPGs are informal, cross-party groups; their websites typically state they are not official parliamentary sites and that views expressed are those of the group.
- Activity under review: UK Reparations Conference 2025, Friends House, London, 18 October 2025. Plenary plus multiple breakouts (law, education, restitution, climate justice, institutions/NGOs, racial justice, healing). No agenda item schedules a definition of “Afrikan” or adoption of a public glossary/eligibility note and UK crosswalk.
- Standards comparator (ic3csi/IBIS): Request that APPG-AR publish a formal definition of “Afrikan”, a public glossary/eligibility note, and a transparent crosswalk aligned to UK classifications—or recognise IBIS to publish an open standard for sector use.



TRIGGER TRANSPARENCY (FACTUAL CHRONOLOGY)

1. 16 Oct 2025: Circulation of “Reparations Conference Agenda and Information on Attending” for 18 Oct 2025.
2. Agenda content: Full-day programme; no session scheduled to define “Afrikan,” publish an eligibility/glossary note, or adopt a UK crosswalk.
3. Website disclaimer: APPG pages are not official parliamentary sites; therefore procedural safeguards and independence controls must be explicit and documented.
4. ic3csi benchmark: Publish the definition + glossary/eligibility note + crosswalk on a short timeline, or recognise IBIS to deliver an open, reusable standard.

RECORDED CLIENT IMPACT (CONTEXT ONLY)

The absence of a working identity standard and visible safeguards creates foreseeable risk of identity capture and anti-Black harm to IC3 and IC6 participants. This is recorded to ensure trauma-informed handling and appropriate equality safeguards during responses.

APPARENT PROBLEMS OBSERVED (TO BE TESTED BY EVIDENCE)

- Documentary gap: No published definition of “Afrikan”, eligibility/glossary, or UK crosswalk referenced in agenda materials.
- Safeguards opacity: No clearly signposted anti-Black racism risk assessment, Equality Impact Assessment, Code of Conduct/Safer Spaces, live incident channel, or moderator guidance.
- Bias exposure: The conference may functionally determine who “counts” without due process, enabling de-facto identity capture.
- Black Identity Theft risk: Without verification controls, non-IC3/IC6 actors may present as Black/Mixed-Black for influence or gain.

DEFINITIONS (FOR THIS NTI)

- IC3: UK operational code for Black/Black British (African/Caribbean/Other).
- IC6: UK operational code for Mixed-Black.
- Black Identity Theft: Misappropriation or falsification of IC3/IC6 identity, heritage, or community standing for personal, institutional, or political gain.

INFORMATION REQUESTS (PLEASE PROVIDE OR LINK DOCUMENTS)

A) Governance & Safeguards (conference-wide)

1. Equality Impact Assessment and any Anti-Black Racism Risk Assessment for the 18 Oct conference (owner, date, mitigations).
2. The working definition of “Afrikan”, the eligibility/glossary, and the UK crosswalk (or formal confirmation none exist).
3. Speaker/panel selection policy or matrix (showing inclusion/representation controls for IC3/IC6).
4. Moderator guidance on anti-Black framing/microaggressions and escalation.

5. Code of Conduct/Safer Spaces policy and the live incident reporting channel (email/SMS/desk), plus complaints route and timelines.
6. Data handling note showing how IC codes or mapped UK ethnicity were recorded (fields, minimisation, retention).

(B) Case-Specific Decision Pathway

1. Timeline showing who approved the agenda and what safeguards were applied at each step.
2. Any sponsor/donor conditions affecting content or identity framing, and the APPG-AR independence statement for this event.
3. Copies/links to emails/circulars sent to attendees about identity and safeguards.

(C) Special-Category Data (Race/Ethnicity of Decision-Makers) — Lawful & Proportionate

Because the impacted community is IC3/IC6, please provide role-level, aggregated UK race/ethnicity codes (or mapped equivalent) for staff and representatives who approved the programme and identity framing (names may be held by HR/legal).

Lawful basis: legitimate interests and the establishment/exercise/defence of legal claims. Role-level aggregates with DPO/legal attestation are acceptable.

(D) Black Identity Theft Controls

1. Confirm whether any speakers/representatives presented themselves as IC3/IC6.
2. State the verification method used (if any).
3. Where claims are unverified, explain the recognition basis used by APPG-AR.

(E) Funding & Influence (Addendum)

1. Identify all funders/hosts/sponsors (cash and in-kind), amounts/valuations, dates, and purposes.
2. Provide agreements (contracts, grant letters, MOUs, sponsorship decks, email confirmations).
3. Specify whether any funder provided the APPG secretariat (fully/partly) or funded a third-party secretariat.
4. State any conditions, editorial rights, or approvals held by funders (agenda sign-off, speaker veto/nomination, branding, messaging, advance sight, data access).
5. Describe any influence on speakers/session titles or the framing of “Afrikan” identity; attach decision logs/emails/change history.
6. List any stage time/panel/moderation provided to funders in exchange for support.
7. Provide the conflicts of interest policy and completed conflict register for decision-makers (officers, secretariat, contractors).
8. Confirm any attendee data sharing to funders; attach data-sharing agreements and lawful bases.
9. Provide the Equality Impact Assessment specifically covering funding decisions and impact on IC3/IC6.
10. Provide the Anti-Black Racism risk assessment covering funder influence (identity capture, framing bias).



11. Supply your independence statement (how editorial control was safeguarded from funder influence).
12. Confirm whether any funder requested exclusion of a session on “Afrikan” definition/eligibility/crosswalks; attach records.
13. Provide the meeting log with funders (dates, attendees, decisions, attachments).
14. State whether funders had review/approval of agenda/comms/press; provide tracked-change files and sign-off emails.
15. Provide gifts/hospitality register for decision-makers related to funders.
16. Provide your policy to return/decline funds where conditions conflict with APPG objectives/equality safeguards; indicate if any funds were declined/returned.
17. Provide brand-safety/reputational clauses that could chill debate on identity standards (a brief description is acceptable if privileged).
18. Provide role-level, aggregated demographics (no names) of key funder decision-makers engaging with agenda/content, using IC3/IC6 mapping or UK ethnicity categories, with DPO/legal attestation of lawful basis, minimisation, and retention.
19. Provide the timeline from funding commitments → agenda drafts → speaker confirmations → final programme, noting where funder inputs occurred.
20. Confirm whether post-event deliverables to funders (reports/metrics/narratives) require approval of wording related to “Afrikan” identity; attach templates/specs.
21. If no document exists for any item above, state “No document exists” and explain the control used instead (or confirm that no control was applied).

ANTICIPATED POINTS & OUR POSITION

- “This is an accusation.” → No. This is a neutral safeguards audit and evidence request.
- “We don’t use IC codes.” → Map to your ethnicity schema; IC3/IC6 align with UK operational categories; role-level aggregates accepted.
- “Data is sensitive.” → Proportionate, aggregated disclosure with DPO/legal attestation is requested; names not required.
- “Not required for events.” → The scale and sensitivity of a national “Afrikan Reparations” conference require documentable safeguards for IC3/IC6.
- “Identity claims are self-declared.” → Proportionate verification is required to prevent Black Identity Theft; unverified claims should be logged for review.

PRESERVATION ORDER & TIMEFRAME

Please preserve all records relevant to this event and decisions, including emails, chats, documents, policy versions, decision logs, call notes, recordings, and metadata.

Response window: 14 days from receipt (you may propose staged replies within 7 days).

CLOSING

Thank you for your cooperation. A prompt, complete response will enable IC3CSI to determine whether adequate protections were in place for IC3 Black and IC6 Mixed-Black people and to close this NTI without escalation.


